### **CHOPPED BODIES OF TWO PERSONS RECOVERED IN NUEVA VIZCAYA**

Investigators and forensic experts of the Philippine National Police are now looking into the identity of two male persons recovered in Barangay Baretret, Bagabag, Nueva Vizcaya.

PCSupt Rowland Albano, Regional Director of PRO2 in his report to Camp Crame said that residents of the said barangay reported to the police the discovery of the two bodies on December 1, 2000 at 7:30 A.M.

The chopped bodies were placed in two (2) plastic bags and dumped along the roadside of San Lorenzo Ruiz Bridge. Both wrists of the two victims were still handcuffed and both the heads are missing.

The cadaver of one of the victims described to be white the other who was fair complexioned was chopped into twelve pieces.

Initial investigation disclosed that the two bodies were dumped in the area between 8:00 P.M. and 9:00 P.M. on November 30, 2000. A Tamaraw FX colored white and a maroon pick-up were allegedly spotted dumping the two (2) plastic bags.

Finger printing and other laboratory examinations are now being conducted to determine the identity of the two persons.
