All PNP Regional Police Offices nationwide have been placed on heightened alert as a result of the bombing incidents in Metro-Manila.

The different Police Regional Directors have cancelled all leaves/passes of PNP Personnel and recalled them back to their respective stations.

Director General Panfilo Lacson earlier gave the Regional Directors the authority to determine the status of alert in their respective areas as each has its own peculiar situation.

PINSP NESTOR SALVADOR who was reported in an earlier statement to be in critical condition already expired because of massive shrapnel wounds. PINSP Salvador was critically wounded while SPO4 Roberto Gutierrez died on the spot when they tried to defuse a bomb in Makati yesterday afternoon.

General Lacson promoted posthumously the two Makati cops to the next higher rank for their acts of heroism and for offering their lives so others may live.

Meanwhile, police investigators are pursuing a good lead and will present the result of the investigation once the details are completed.

In the meantime, we advise all to remain calm and avoid speculating on the incident as this will further create confusion.

We assure our people that the PNP is on top of the situation and doing its best to prevent similar occurrence.

Let us also remain vigilant and report all suspicious acts or movements of people to the nearest police station.
