UPDATE ON THE DISCOVERY OF TWO CHOPPED BODIES IN NUEVA VIZCAYA

The two chopped bodies recovered in Nueva Vizcaya have been formally turned-over by Provincial Director PSUPT Romeo Hilomen to the PNP Crime Laboratory in Camp Crame for further examination.

Investigators from the PNP Criminal Investigation and Detection Group (CIDG) were dispatched to Bagabag, Nueva Vizcaya to conduct a deeper probe of the case.

Efforts are also being made to trace from where the "PNP handcuffs" with serial number 718404 came. The said handcuffs were recovered inside one of the plastic bags where the chopped bodies were discovered.

The PNP is now verifying the registration of the Tamaraw Revo which was seen at the place of the incident to determine its ownership.

The CIDG has taken the lead role as far as the PNP investigation of the case of the missing Bubby Dacer and his driver Manuel Corbito is concerned. All investigative efforts of the WPD and SPD of NCRPO, Cavite PNP, Nueva Vizcaya PNP and other concerned PNP units closely coordinated by CIDG.

CIDG will closely coordinate by the parallel investigations being conducted by the PAOCTF & NBI.

Meanwhile, coordination has been made with Mr. Edwin Farga, the spokesman of the Dacer family for possible identification of the recovered bodies. It is an SOP to request relatives of missing persons to identify recovered bodies.
