113 POSITIONS FOR PNP OFFICERS

The Philippine National Police is in need of 113 Police Commissioned Officers to fill-up shortages of personnel in the Technical Services.

PNP Spokesman, Senior Superintendent Nicanor A Bartolome announced that the concerned National Support Units are now accepting applications to fill-up the positions.

The available positions are open to qualified doctors, lawyers, engineers, pilots, chemists, dentists, medical technologists, criminologists, priests, and other professionals.

Successful applicants will be appointed into the PNP Officer Corps with the initial rank of Police Inspector (Lieutenant) with a basic monthly salary of P13, 400.00.

Medical doctors and lawyers, on the other hand, will be appointed to the initial rank of Senior Inspector (Captain) with a basic monthly salary of P14, 438.00.

"On top of the monthly salary," Bartolome said, "they will also receive allowances and other financial benefits."

Bartolome explained that the PNP is widening the search for qualified applicants and adapting more rigid screening standards.

"We want to get only the best and the most qualified for the positions," Bartolome said.

Applicants may report in person at the respective National Support Units offices for processing.
