One World Against Terrorism **ACPPI 3rd NATIONAL CONVENTION**

The Association of Chiefs of Police of the Philippines Inc.(ACPPI) will hold its 3rd National Convention on **November 24, 2001** at the Camp Crame Multi-Purpose Hall in Quezon City.

Former Education Secretary, Dr. Andrew B Gonzalez, President of the Manila Bulletin is guest of honor and speaker.

High in the agenda of the 3rd ACPPI National Convention is the ratification of the Magna Carta for Policemen which is now pending before Congress.

Over 300 ACPPI members from all over the country are expected to gather in Camp Crame for the Convention and General Assembly held under the theme "*One World Against Terrorism.*"

Simultaneous lectures on pressing national issues will be conducted during the Convention. Among them are the law enforcement concerns on terrorism, drug trafficking, transnational crimes, and modern trends in police procedures.

Aside from the Magna Carta for Policemen, also expected to be discussed are related issues affecting the police service such as the PNP Foundation, and proposed amendments to the PNP Reform and Reorganization Law.

The ACPPI is a non-stock, non-profit organization of the police officers patterned after the 108-year old International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP) based in the United States.

The goals of the ACPPI are to advance the science and art of police service, to foster exchange of information and experience among police

administrators, and to encourage adherence to high standards of performance and conduct.

The ACPPI also aims to foster unity among the sectors representing the different sources of commission for police officers.
