PNP HOLDS SEMINAR ON TERRORISM

In support to the directive of President Gloria Macapagal Arroyo to conduct information campaign on the issue of terrorism, PNP Chief, Director General Leandro R Mendoza through the Directorate for Human Resource and Doctrine Development have started a series of seminars on Theories and Politics of Terrorism. The purpose of the activity is to educate PNP personnel, including the public, on the said subject so that they can better appreciate the present situation.

Participants to the seminar are Human resource and Police Community Relations Officers of different Police regional and Provincial Offices, National Support Units, Directors of City Police Offices, and Chief of Police of highly urbanized municipalities.

Public Information Officers of Local Government Units (LGU), NGOs, and representatives from the labor, business, professional, and student sectors are also invited to attend.

The DHRDD under Director Florencio D Fianza has so far held five seminars with a total of 424 participants from the NCRPO, PROs 3 and 4, an Police Officers undergoing training at the Philippine Public Safety College in Fort Bonifacio, Makati City.

The PNP will continue to hold this kind of seminars nationwide through the DHRDD Mobile Training Team headed by Senior Superintendent Augusto Angcanan Jr.

The team is also available to give lectures in schools, universities, civic organizations, and other interested groups.
