POLICE PMAyers CENSURE FELLOW CAVALIER

The Police Cavaliers Association Inc. (PCAI), an organization of Philippine Military Academy alumni serving in the Philippine National Police, strongly denounced the "irresponsible statement" made by a fellow Cavalier before a Senate investigation committee.

The PCAI yesterday passed Resolution No. 01-10-2001 denouncing Police Superintendent Francisco Villaroman for the "sweeping, very unfair, and disrespectful" statement he made before the joint Committee hearings at the Senate last Tuesday.

The PCAI Resolution was signed by PCAI Chairman, Deputy Director General Rex D Piad; and PCAI President, Chief Superintendent Romulo D Sales.

In his opening statement before the joint Senate committees Tuesday, Villaroman stated that "PMA graduates are the ones creating all the problems here in the country."

The PCAI said Villaroman's statement "is clearly not representative of the sentiments of the Police Cavaliers Association Inc., and the Philippine Military Academy Alumni Association Inc. (PMAAAI)."

"The PCAI is always guided by the PNP motto: Courage, Integrity, Loyalty, and Solemnity pledges loyalty to the Republic of the Philippines, the Constitution, the Commander-in-Chief, and the duly constituted authorities," the police Cavaliers said.

"The statement of Supt. Villaroman is too sweeping, very unfair, and at worst disrespectful to the majority of the Cavaliers who are professionally dispensing their jobs and upholding their Alma Mater's motto," they said.

Similar reactions to Villaroman's statement were also raised by other PMA graduates now serving the military, government service, and private sector.
