No funds for early retirees

RETIRE COPS SEEK REINSTATEMENT

A total of 310 retired PNP personnel have signified intention to return to active service because of the non-availability of retirement benefits.

These retirees are among the 3,141 PNP personnel who availed of the Early Retirement Program (ERP) of the PNP as early as May 1998, but until now have not received the retirement benefits provided under the law.

Some 2,235 of these early retirees are still awaiting the release of their retirement benefits by the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) amounting to P1.195-billion.

PNP Chief, Director General Leandro R Mendoza has issued a set of guidelines to implement the resolution of the National Police Commission authorizing the reinstatement of PNP personnel who have availed of early retirement.

Mendoza has instructed the Directorate for Personnel and Records Management (DPRM) to process applications for reinstatement of the retired personnel.

The applications for reinstatement of the 310 retired personnel who opted for reinstatement are now being processed by the DPRM.

Retired personnel seeking reinstatement are required to submit a letter addressed to the Chief PNP, a duly accomplished leave form, orders of Early Retirement, and a certification from the Finance Service regarding the status of their Commutation of Accrued Leave (CAL).

Retire personnel who have filed Certificates of Candidacy during the recent May 14, 2001 elections are prohibited from reinstatement into the service.

The approving authority for reinstatement of early retirees are: The Director for Personnel and Records Management- for PO1 to SPO4; The Chief of Directorial Staff- for Inspector to Senior Inspector; The Deputy Chief for Administration- for Chief Inspector to Superintendent; and the Chief PNP- for Senior Superintendent and higher ranks.
