OFFICER CORPS, RANK AND FILE BACK PNP LEADERSHIP

The Officer Corps, and rank and file of the Philippine National Police today manifested its unwavering support to the leadership of Police Director General Hermogenes E Ebdane Jr. amid the disapproval by some quarters of the latest PNP reorganization.

Separate manifesto of support were passed today by different Police Regional Offices, National Support Units and other PNP Offices, including the Police Sergeants-Major and the Association of Chiefs of Police of the Philippines, Inc. (ACPPI).

"The trying situation call for unity and solidarity in thought and in deed," the PNP officers said in their manifesto.

They expressed a common sentiment of trust on the wisdom of Ebdane's order to reorganize the PNP to make it responsive in its mandated task of maintaining peace and order, and to fully address the current crime situation.

Meantime, the 2,000-strong ACPPI issued a similar manifesto expressing solidarity with and support for the PNP leadership.

The ACPPI manifesto signed by President Arturo C Lomibao and Chairman Guillermo T Domondon cited the competence and work ethics of Ebdane that has effectively inspired the police to do their jobs.

They also acknowledged Ebdane's determination to win the war against criminality and terrorism.

The ACPPI is an organization of both active and retired police officers and civilians who have distinguished themselves in law enforcement and public service.
