COCAINE, MARIJUANA, DRUG PARAPHERNALIA, PASSPORTS SEIZED IN MAGALLANES VILLAGE SEARCH OPERATION

Operatives of Task Force Hunter of the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) confiscated cocaine, marijuana, drug paraphernalia and two passports during a search and seizure operation in a house in Magallanes Village, Makati City.

The operation also resulted in the arrested of a 40-year-old man who holds two passports with same pictures bearing different names.

In his report to Undersecretary Anselmo S. Avenido Jr., PDEA Director General, Director Reynaldo H. Jaylo, PDEA TF Hunter Chief, said the operation was conducted on Nov. 8 (Saturday) at Nov. 18 San Carlos St., Magallanes Village, Makati City by virtue of a search warrant issued by Judge Manuel D. Victorio of RTC Branch 139.

Jaylo identified the suspect as Jerome John P. Magno. He holds two passports. One is a US Passport No. 710109435 under the name of Jerome John P. Magno, and the other is a Philippine Passport No. BB341846 under the name of Joselito P. Tiglao.

The following items were seized by the PDEA operatives: one small transparent plastic bag containing white powder suspected to be cocaine; one yellow paper bag with markings British India containing undetermined dried marijuana seed and leaves; one small cloth bag colored gold containing aluminum foil and two pieces of red aluminum foil with dried marijuana leaves; one small black box with markings Natural American Spirit containing three pieces of bubble funk with suspected ,marijuana seeds; one small brown envelope containing suspected marijuana seeds; one blue plastic container containing

unknown particles covered with white paper and rubber band; one small orange plastic containing 63 pieces of small pink tablets; and one small plastic sprayer containing suspected peppermint liquid.

The drug paraphernalia confiscated were a digital weighing scale, four pieces of glass tooters, two pieces of wooden cigarette pipes, one piece of stainless manual presser/grinder, one small burner, one blue weighing scale with aluminum bowl, 12 boxes with markings Smoking Slim containing cigarette wrapper known as rolling papers, an old Panasonic cellular phone, one plastic bag containing plastic wrapper, and two pieces of plastic lighters.

The operatives also confiscated two plastic bag of Tampax, one plastic bottle of TUMS E.X., and a small bottle of Steam Inhalant Solution.

The operation was conducted in an orderly manner in the presence of members of Makati City Police led by PSSUPT Jovito A. Gutierrez, Marilou Gordon, Barangay Chairwoman, Barangay Maagallanes, and Amado V. Balbuena, Barangay Chief Tanod and Security Commander.

A case for violation of Republic Act 9165, or the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act, has been file against Magno.
