PNP CELEBRATES EID AL-FITR

The Philippine National Police joins the entire Filipino nation in celebration of Eid Al-Fitr, marking the culmination of the 30-day observance of the Islamic Holy Month of Ramadhan.

PNP Chief, Director General Hermogenes E. Ebdane Jr. leads PNP officials in celebrating this important Islamic holiday which is observed by all Muslim faithful around the world.

Chief Superintendent Oscar Valenzuela, Director of the Police Community Relations Group (PCRG) announced that early morning activities will be held in Camp Crame tomorrow (Nov. 25) to commemorate Eid Al-Fitr.

Muslims among PNP personnel and their dependents are expected to participate in the religious festivities at the Multi-Purpose Center which starts off at 5:00 AM with the recital of the Islamic prayer Talbir Mursal and congregation prayer of Salaatul Eid El-Fitr.

After the Islamic prayers, a breakfast forum allows at 8:30 AM to be participated by several invited Imam.

According to Valenzuela, the participation of the PNP in the Islamic celebration of Eid Al-Fitr manifests the PNP's open advocacy policy of religious tolerance, under the Neighborhood Partnership component of the O.N.E. PNP Program of Action of the PNP leadership.

"The open advocacy of religious tolerance is a factor to bring forth lasting peace in the entire Filipino nation without discriminating on beliefs and cultures," Valenzuela said.
