85 POLICE COLONELS TAKE OATH

Eighty-five (85) police officers were promoted today to the rank of Senior Superintendent during simple rites at the PNP National Headquarters in Camp Crame.

PNP Chief, Director General Hermogenes E Ebdane Jr. administered the Oath of Office to the newly-promoted officials.

"It has been a policy of the PNP leadership to ensure the professional career advancement of all personnel. We are starting off with the senior officers and this will cascade down the line." Ebdane said.

A series of regular promotions in the PNP Officer Corps is expected soon to take the place of retires, separated and deceased personnel.

Police Director Jose Lalisan, PNP Director for Personnel and Records Management (DPRM) said the promotions were based on the recommendation of the Senior Officers' Placement and Promotion Board (SOPPB).

According to Lalisan, the promotion of the 85 police officials is part of the regular promotion cycle for Senior Superintendents.

Regular promotion of other police officers to higher ranks is now undergoing deliberation by the SOPPB and the designated Promotions Board, and are expected to be finished soon.

Currently there are some 600 Senior Superintendents in the active service.
